After School Clubs Descriptions

Basketball

Enjoy the fun of playing basketball while learning the skills and techniques necessary to improve your game. This is an instructional clinic, including drills, exercises and scrimmaging in an effort to improve your game. The boys' clinic will be taught by Yicheol Tanenbaum. The girls' clinic will be taught by Bonnie Orgel.

Soccer

Spencer Rockman and his associates are back with Rovers Soccer. Through "soccernastics" and skill building games of dribbling, passing and shooting, Rovers Soccer creates an environment of fun and fitness designed to foster growth in your child's motor skills, coordination and group interaction.

Choir

The choir club allows students to develop their talent in singing and performing. Singing with the chorus gives children a forum to work together to bring life to music of great beauty, and to share this achievement with others. This process of ensemble music-making cultivates a sense of responsibility, commitment, self-discipline, confidence and poise- key ingredients for success in any field or endeavor. The club is directed by Fresh Theatre Arts Musical Director, Avi Wolf. At the end of the 8 week session, students will perform in a showcase for their families and friends.

Sewing

Each class will cover a different hand sewing skill: sewing buttons, cross stitching, and simple embroidery. Hand sewing is great for kids during quiet time at home or on road trips and long airplane rides. No previous sewing skills needed. Boys and girls are welcome. Mrs. Debra Tune will be the instructor.

Mini Ballet

Classes are narrative in nature as students are led through a series of movement stories and ballet-based activities that appeal to both girls and boys alike. The creative movement in each story enhances the development of fine and gross motor skills as they balance, skip, leap, coordinate, isolate and move to the music. Social skills are also developed through collaborative and cooperative games.

Intro to Ballet

This class is designed for the novice dancer with no previous experience or the student who wants to refine their technique at a basic level. Students will learn the basic positions, correct body alignment both hands on and an introduction to basic ballet terminology.

Hip Hop

Hip hop is a high-energy class that infuses the latest styles of street dancing, breaking, popping, and locking. Classes will encourage students to step outside of the box by bringing their own individual style and personality to the movements.

Karate

The "Shua Fun Do" system is a combination of Japanese Karate and Chinese Kung Fu techniques and principles with an emphasis on having fun while learning. Once your child takes this class, he/she will have an advantage in any type of martial arts school in the future. The techniques of different styles are easy to learn. Here the students will also learn discipline, respect and how to enjoy martial arts.

Story Time and Activities

Mrs. Weisel brings her enthusiasm and creativity to our after school clubs. In this class your children will develop a love of books. After listening to stories children will enjoy activities related to the book. Activities may include a craft, acting out the story or a book club type of discussion about the moral of story.

Arts and Crafts

Students will enjoy an hour of fun, creating and designing projects with Ms. Liebhaber. Developmental benefits of art include motor skills, visual learning and inventiveness and decision making.
